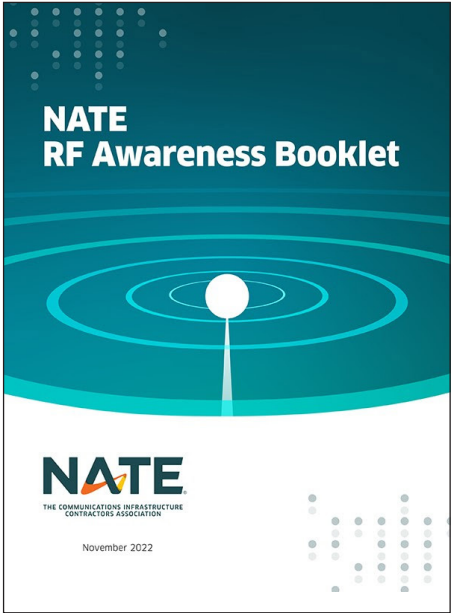
NATE RF Awareness Booklet Free to Association Members
